

## Tools for Travel in Your Foretravel RV

(Note: Tools carried are personal due to electrical / mechanical abilities of each; some find it relaxing to work on their RV, others find it mystifying & hate it. It is best to treat RV as second home with complete tool items; do not swap out items with / from your stick home – equip both separately.)

2. 3 LED flashlights (small - hand)
3. 12 volt LED work light
4. Batteries (extra)
5. First aid kit
6. Reflective safety vests (2)
7. Triangle road reflectors
8. Safety road flares (3 min)
9. Leatherman / Gerber multi-tool
10. Dremel tool with attachments
11. Scotch 33 blk electrical tape
12. Duct tape rolls (3)
13. Aluminum tape rolls
14. Tube of Silicone sealer – clear
15. Tube of Silicone sealer – white
16. Teflon pipe tape – 2 rolls
17. Corrosion X – large spray can
18. Silicone lube spray can
19. PB Blaster spray can
20. Anti-seize lubricant
21. Plastic funnels (sm, md, lg)
22. Heavy clear plastic drop cloth
23. Multimeter (a good unit)
24. 12 volt tester light
25. 120 volt tester
26. Cordless drill / flashlight
27. Alligator clip test leads
28. Assorted wire end terminals
29. Assorted wire end connectors
30. Assorted 120V wire nuts
31. Soldering gun / iron
32. Rosin core solder

The first page is not all inclusive, it is a guide to assist you if new to RVing; everyone will build their own list based upon their mechanical / electrical abilities and their specific RV systems.

“Specific RV systems” is mentioned since some RVs have Aqua-Hot, some have Oasis, some have propane gas, some are total electric with floor heating, etc. – thus needed or required tools / test equipment can vary significantly.

Not shown, but most important and vital to carry / have in every motorhome are the following for your specific engine / transmission: 1) Engine fuel filters – minimum of two sets; 2) Engine oil filters; 3) Engine air filter; 4) Generator fuel filters; 5) Generator oil filters; 6) Generator air filters; 7) Engine belts to drive A/C, alternator, etc.; 8) Desiccant drier filters; 9) TranSynd transmission fluid – two gallons; 10) Shell ELC – extended life coolant – two gallons; 11) 30 to 50 foot electrical power extension cord; 12) Air Hose – 50 feet with quick disconnects; 13) Air pressure gauge – 130+ psi; 14) Water filters & chlorine treatment; 15) Aqua-Hot or Oasis fuel filters; 16) Sewer hose extra length & connectors; 17) Water hose potable & non-potable.

By no means are above lists totally inclusive! Every Foretravel is a custom work of engineering / science / beauty; the list is a starting place for your review to determine what works best for you / your RV and your destination of travel. Most Foretravelers carry their own favorite products to clean their RV exterior, polish interior wood (Zep Wood Doctor), clean windshield and bugs from front endcap, etc. Exterior cleaning requires pole brushes, wipes, squeegees, soaps, microfiber towels, etc.
